



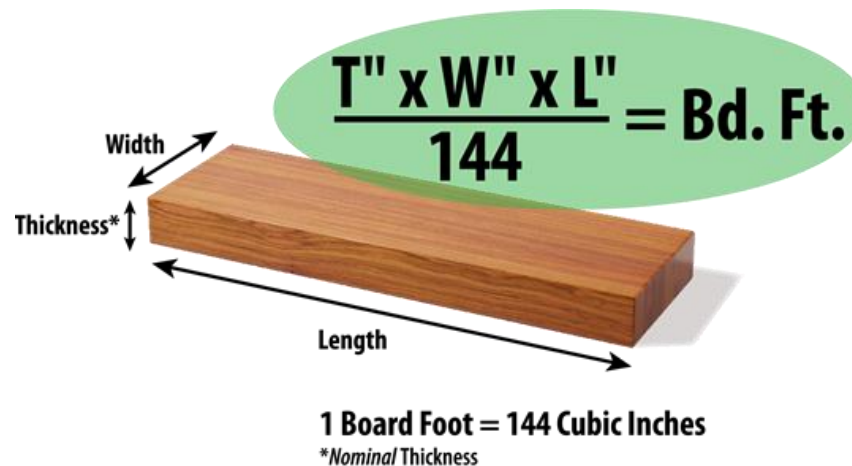

Step 1 Calculate Board Feet

A board foot is a calculation of volume of wood. By using this calculation, you can estimate a cost of a slab and how much to finish one to completion.

Example: Slab is 96"L x 36"W x 2" T/ 144= 48 Board Feet

ALL SLABS ARE 2" INCHES THICK



Labor / Finish Cost per Bd. Ft.

Finishing includes flattening of the slab, sanding to 220 grit, steel reinforcements (c channel), cracks/checks filled with epoxy resin, bowtie/butterfly's if desired, and finished with either an industrial grade water based polyurethane or nitro-cellulose lacquer.
